Composition



Bureau members

'Conference shall elect a President and four vice-Presidents'

Management Committee members

'The Management Committee shall comprise the President of the Conference of States Parties and a State Party representative designated by each **UN regional group**'

Options for Consideration



 Geopolitical regional groupings: The United Nations Regional Groups of Member States, also known as UN 'electoral groups'.

b. **Geographical regional groupings**: A list of geographic regions used by the United Nations Statistics Division.

Geopolitical regional groupings	Geographical regional groupings
States are familiar with the groupingsPoliticized process	 States are less familiar with the groupings Non-politicized process
 Not fully comprehensive: Certain States are omitted Groupings are subject to change over time 	 Comprehensive: <u>All</u> States are included (including countries that are not UN Member States)
