

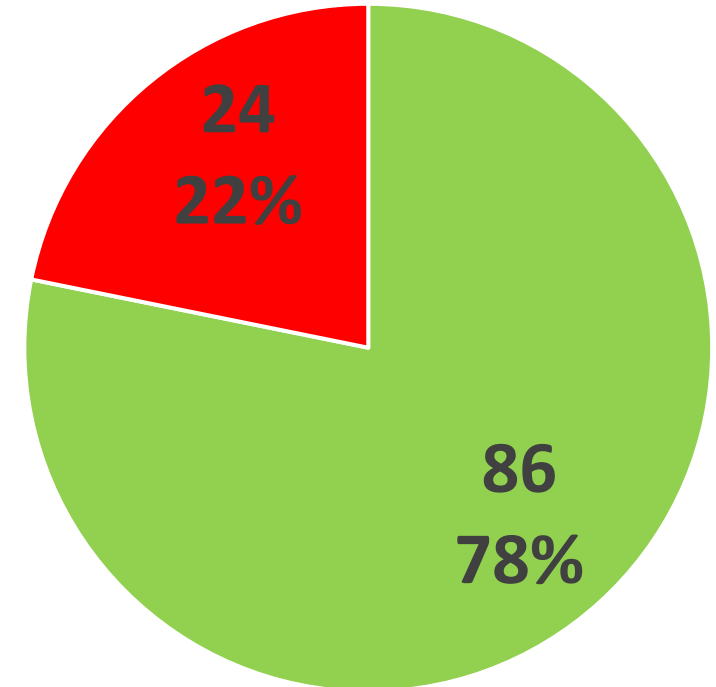

## Global statistics 2015-2023

	No.	%

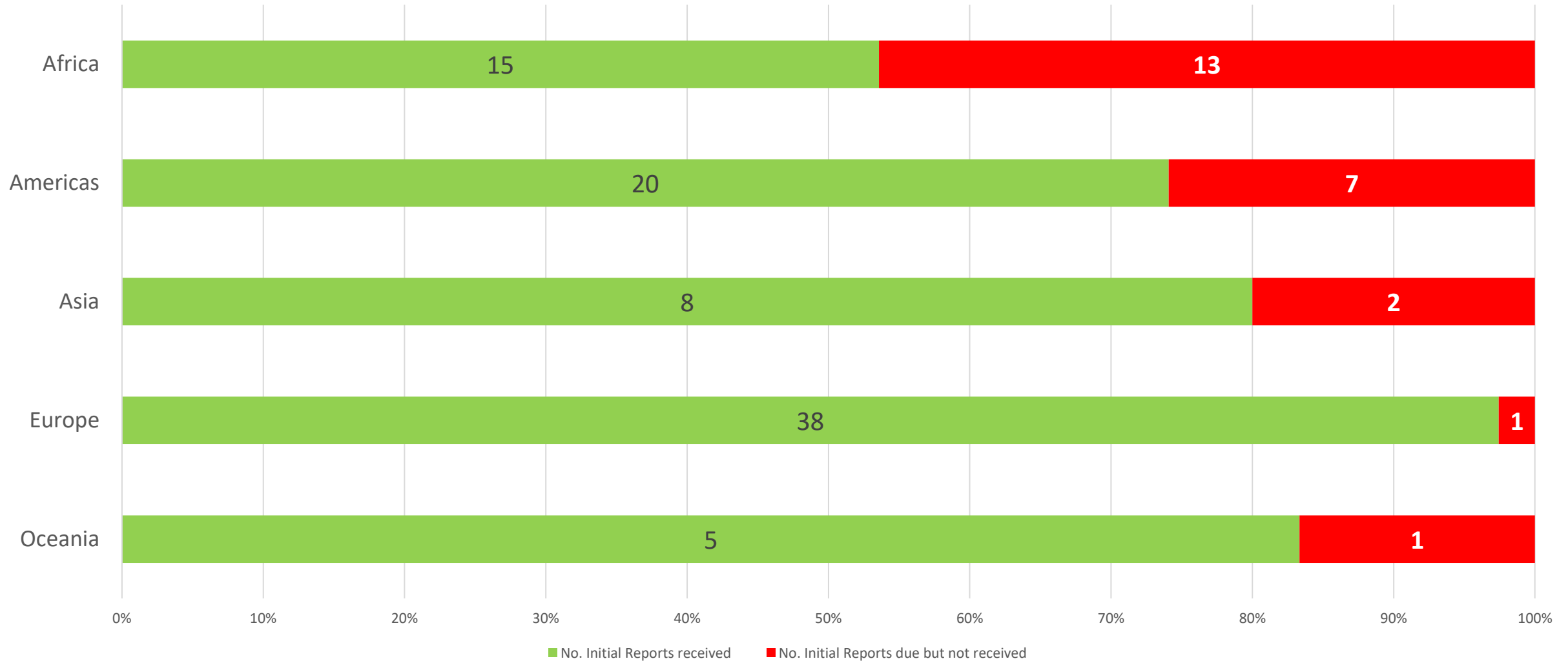

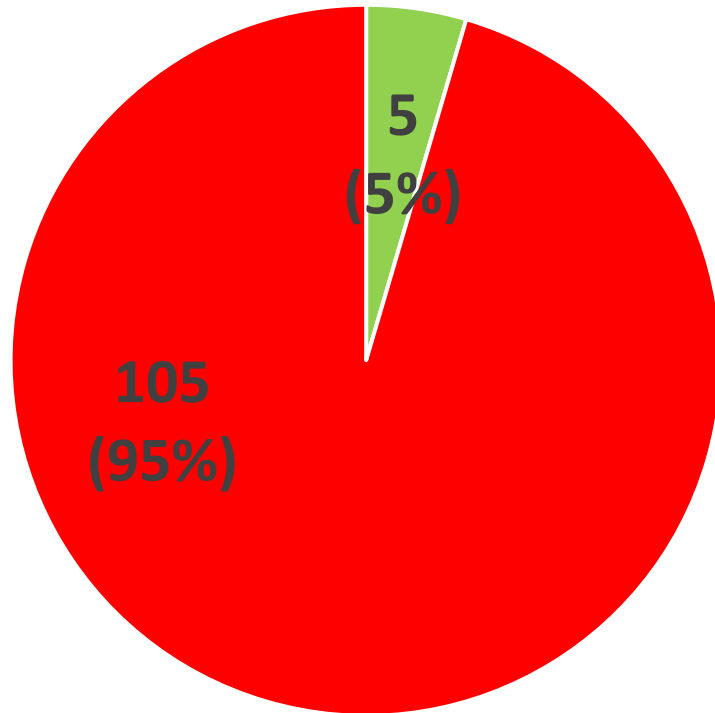

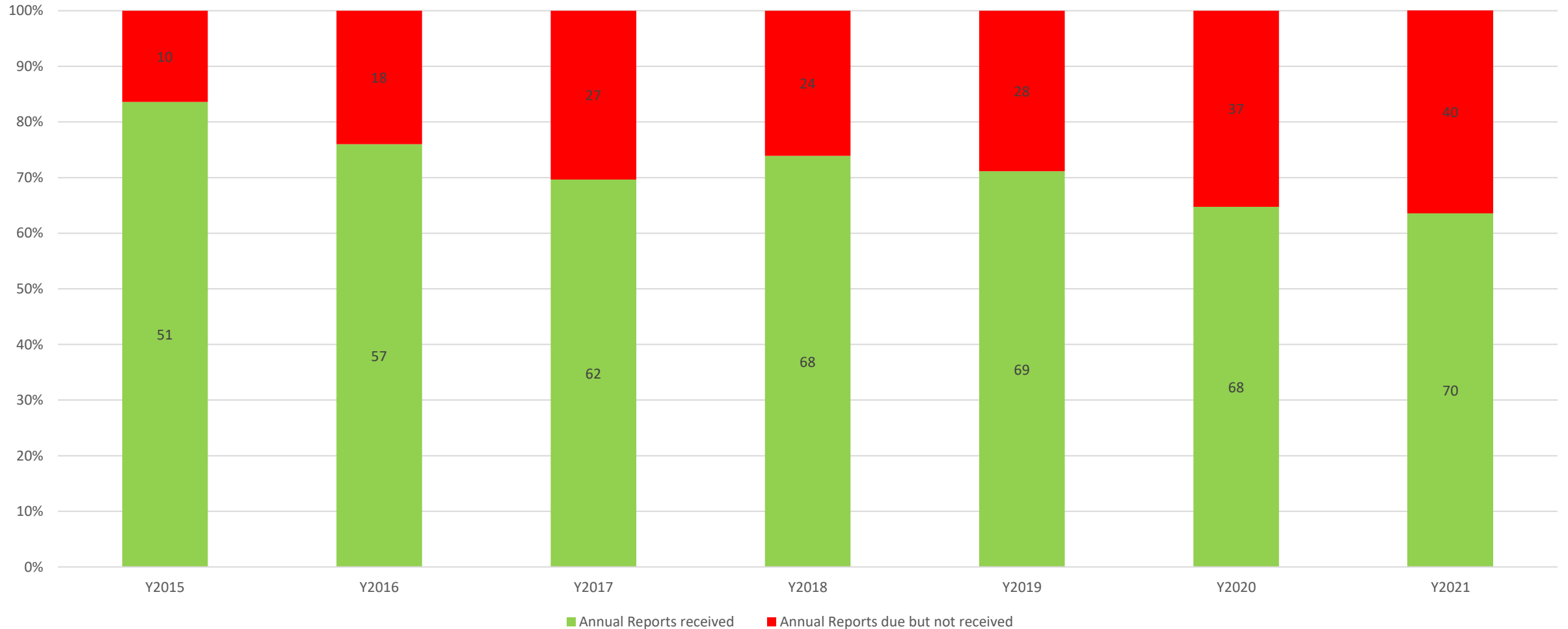

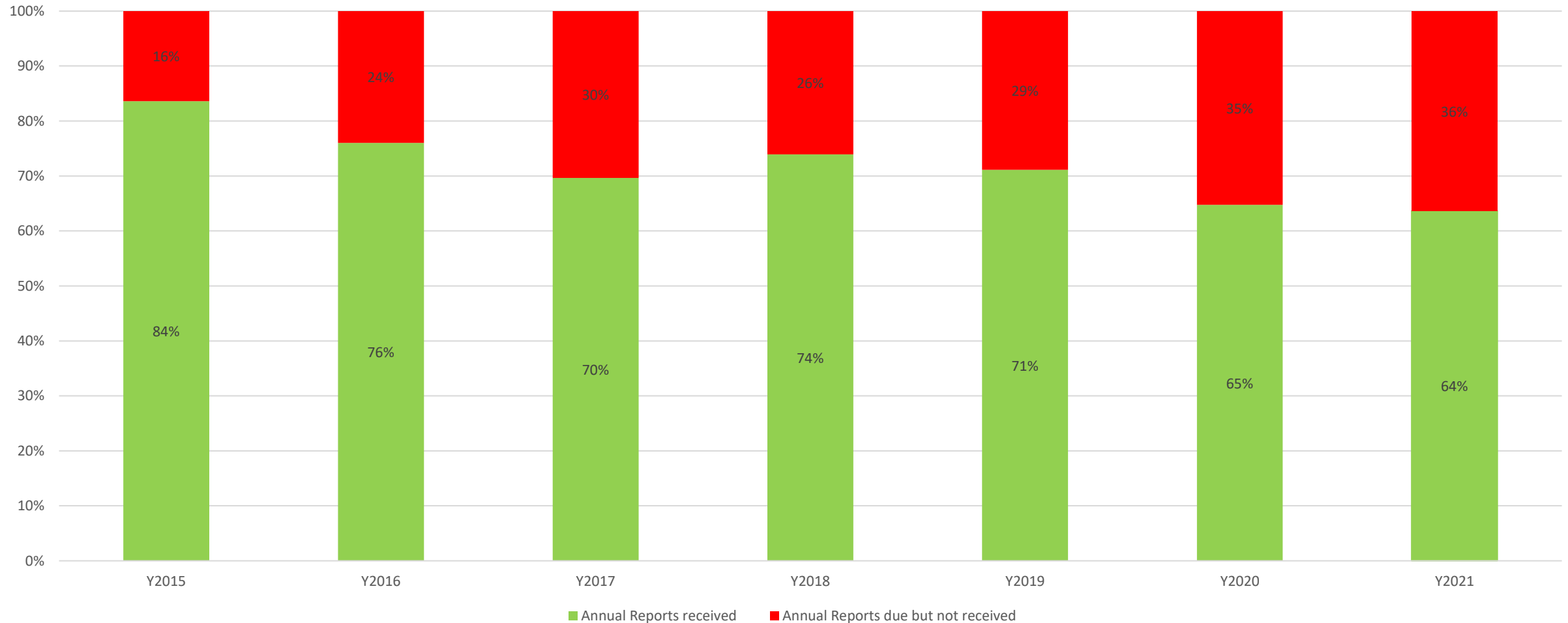
Overview of Annual Report submissions (by no.)

Overview of Annual Report submissions (by %)

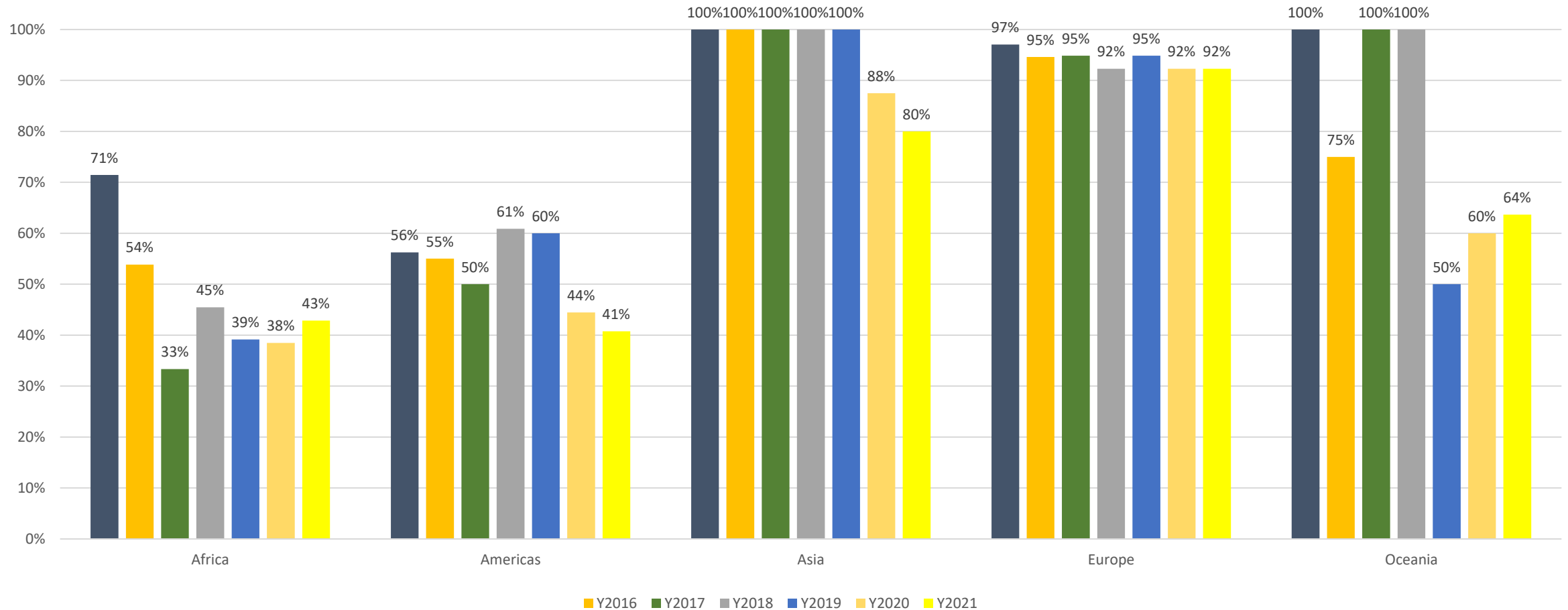

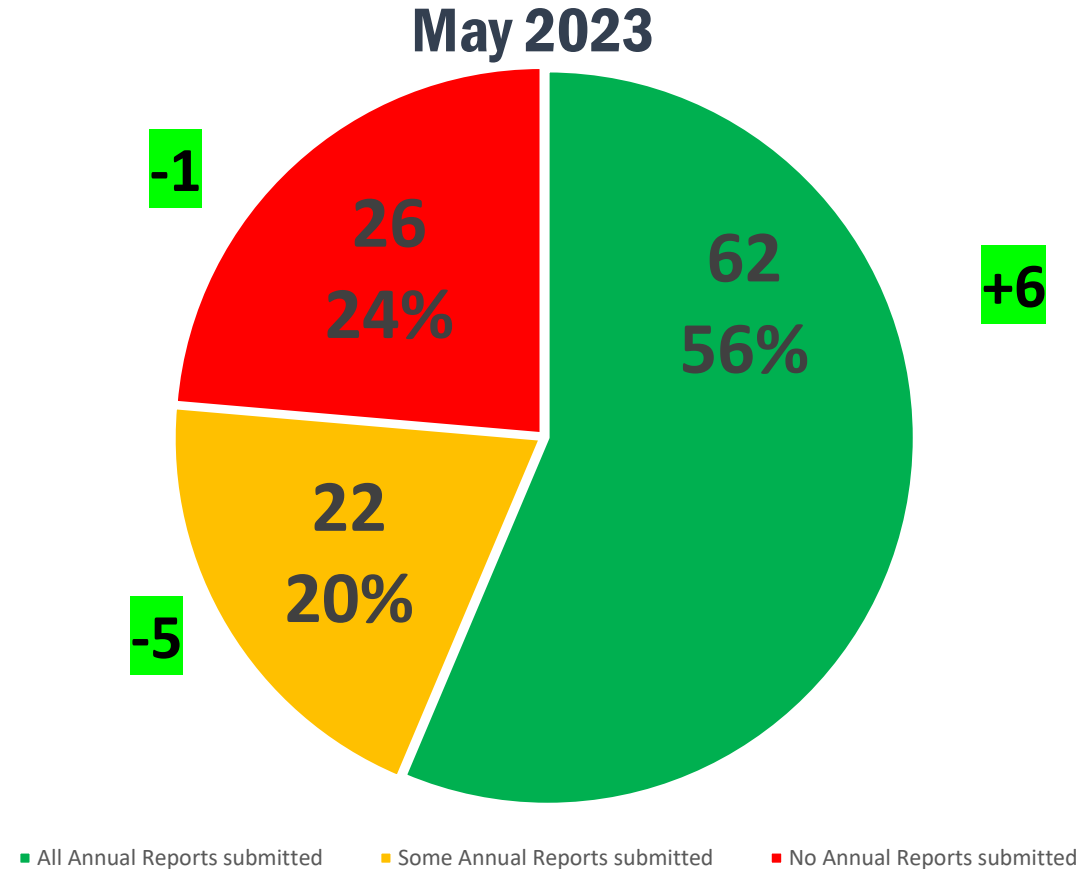
## Regional statistics 2015-2021

## Full, partial and non-submission rates 2015-2021

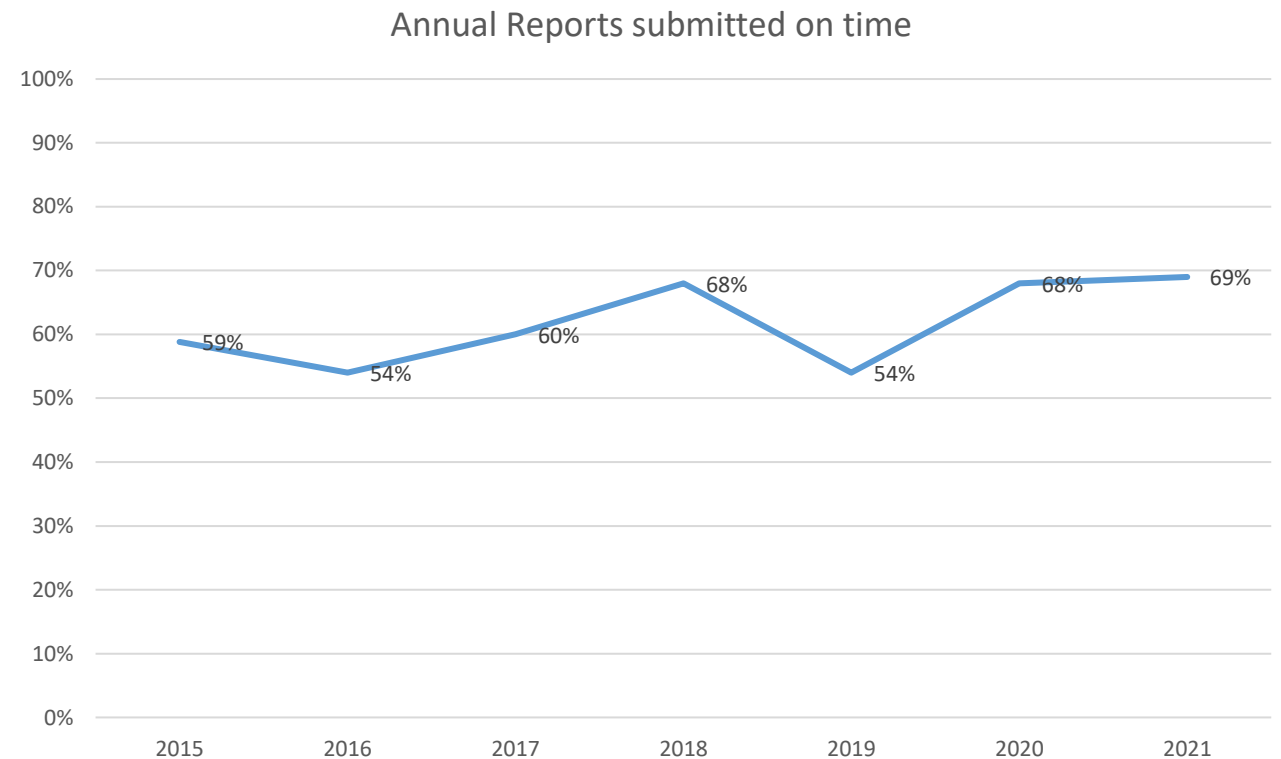

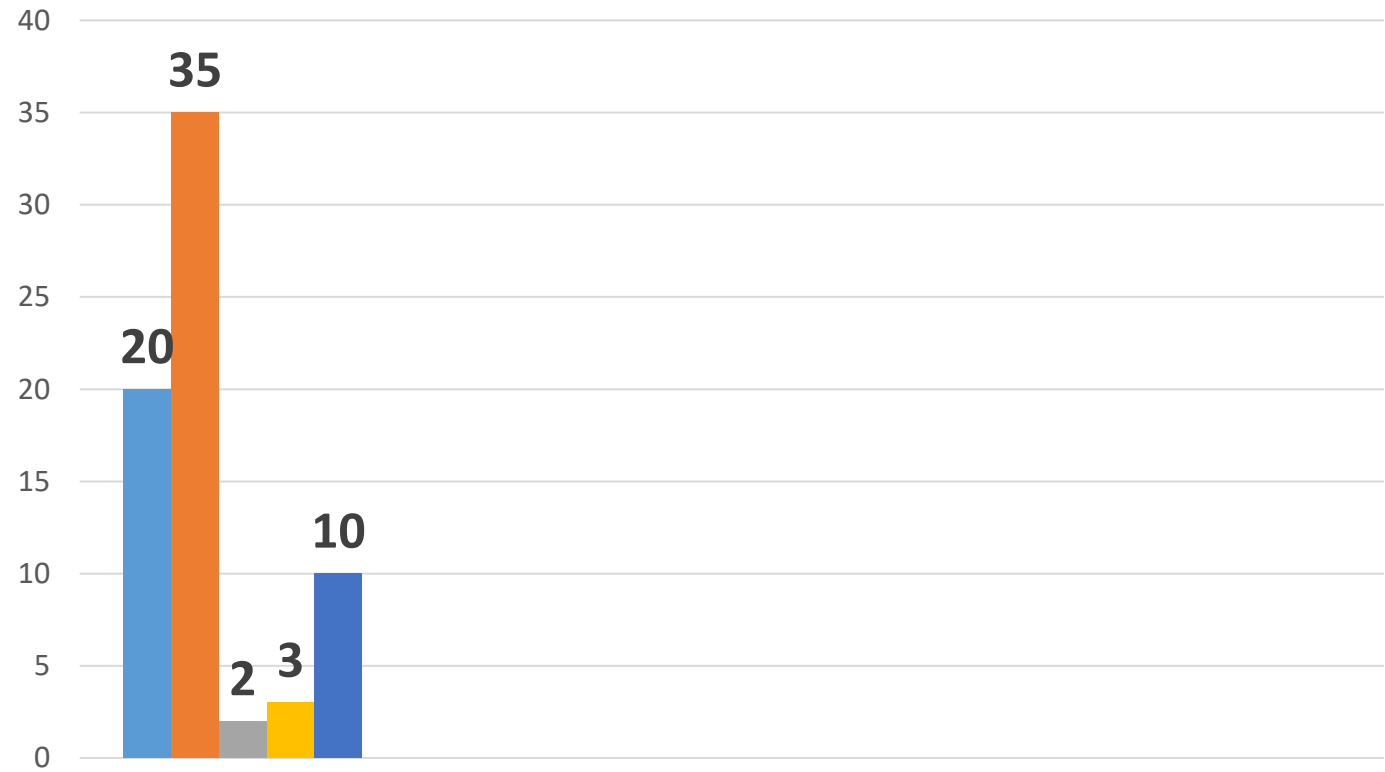

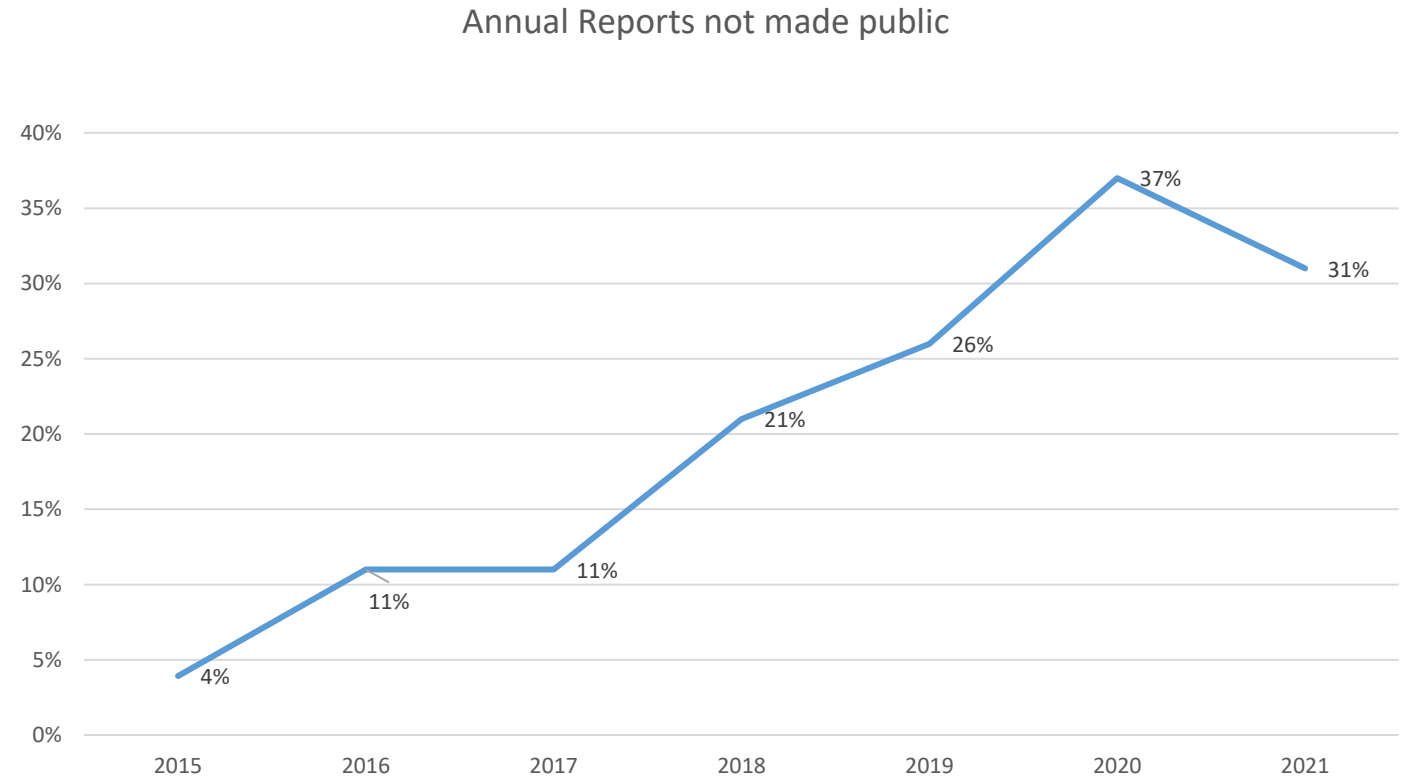
