The event will mark the launch of the Ammunition Assessment and Management Voluntary Self-Assessment (AAMVS) tool, a new resource designed to support both exporters and importers in advancing the objectives of the Arms Trade Treaty (ATT). By helping states strengthen stockpile management and prevent the diversion of ammunition, AAMVS provides a practical way to enhance compliance, build trust, and encourage greater transparency in the international arms trade.

Through a moderated panel discussion, participants will hear from experts and states that have piloted AAMVS, including insights on its benefits, challenges, and lessons learned. The conversation will explore how voluntary self-assessment can guide engagement with donors and partners, support end-user assurances, and inspire broader adoption across the international community. The event will also outline the way forward for AAMVS and discuss how such tools can contribute to stronger cooperation, improved capacity, and more effective implementation of ATT commitments.
