# Arms Trade Treaty Working Group on Transparency and Reporting 23 February 2024

The Philippines assures its fellow State Parties of its continuing commitment to value transparency through the timely submission of its annual reports as mandated by Article 13. The Philippines firmly believes that transparency serves as a crucial factor in inspiring confidence in upholding treaty obligations by allowing states to benchmark their data and implement and coordinate regulatory adjustments for more effective controls to prevent and address the illicit transfers of conventional arms.

In line with this commitment, the Philippines' Department of Trade and Industry - Strategic Trade Management Office has taken proactive steps by establishing an e-licensing platform. This platform functions as a comprehensive one-stop-shop for strategic trade matters, encompassing the application and assessment of authorizations or licenses. Additionally, it serves as a platform for

inter-agency information sharing and streamlines the reporting process, in line with our whole-of-government approach, ensuring compliance with various nonproliferation treaties, including the Arms Trade Treaty (ATT).
