Our accession to the treaty underscores our commitment to peace and security.

The State of Palestine regrets that major arms exporters are not parties to the treaty. We call upon them to do so to put an end to human suffering and maintain regional and international peace and security.

Effective implementation of the treaty is instrumental in its universalization. Double standards and lack of compliance with the ATT hinder its universalization. States Parties, must act responsibly and be role models of the treaty by demonstrating unwavering commitment to the treaty's principles and objectives.
